



STUDENTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following contains sanctions for breaking general rules and regulations of the schools. All students of the school have the responsibilities of ensuring that the school rules and regulation are maintained within the premises of the school. The principal through his office may take any action as may be deemed necessary or expedient to maintain peace.

1. ARSON AND WILFUL DESTRUCTION

Careless or wilful destruction of school properties will attract severe punishment and replacement of such item.

2. STEALING/THEFT

Theft will attract such disciplinary measures as suspension or expulsion.

3. FIGHTING

Fighting is forbidden, student caught fighting will be punished or suspended.

4. UNLAWFUL MEETING AND DEMONSTRATION

Unlawful meeting and demonstration are forbidden. Class boycott is not allowed. Absence from school without permission is punishable. Unlawful gathering and protest, roaming about when lessons are in progress is forbidden.

5. NOISE MAKING

Noise making or distraction of aby kind is not tolerated.

6. **DRUGUSE**

Drug abuse is a criminal offence and punishable by suspension. Students who are on special medication should hand over prescribed drugs to the school staff nurse at the medical center for safe keeping and dispensing. Student who fall sick during school hours should report to the class teacher. Sick student need not to come to school, but the school authority should be informed.

7. **GAMBLING**

Gambling of any kind is forbidden. Toy machines, radios, walk-man. video tapes, recorders computer games, hard currencies, game instrument and gadget should not be brought into the school. Such items seized will not be returned.

8. CULT AND SECRET SOCIETIES

Cultism is highly prohibited, student suspected and found to be connected with cult or secret societies will be expelled. Practicing of strange religious act is not allowed.

9. SMOKING AND USE OF POLLUTANTS

Any student caught with the similitude offence will be expelled. Use of pollutant by the student to drug other student is forbidden.

10. DRUNKENNESS

Drunkenness is forbidden and student suspected of this act will be punished, and consequently be expelled,

11. SCHOOL BELL

It is mandatory for students to obey the school bell whenever it is sounded. Failure to obey the bell is punishable.



12. LANGUAGE USE

The official mode of communication is English language. The national language may be used in class situation. All other forms of languages are not allowed.

13. All student are expected to resume daily at the school premises at 7.30am prompt late comers will be punished and may not be allowed into the classroom until the beginning of a new lesson period.

14. ASSEMBLY

It is mandatory for all students to be present at the school assembly ground. Students are expected to stand attention and sing the national anthem and pledge as it goes on.

15. **CLEANLINESS AND TIDINESS**

It is the responsibility of all the student to tidy up their classes and make use of waste basket provided.

16. SCHOOL UNIFORM AND DRESSING

Every student must appear in his/her school uniform. No other wears is allowed. Only the school recommended shoes must be worn during the school hours. Bathroom sandals are prohibited. Students should be properly dressed and must appear neat and tidy always within and outside the school premises. Dirty, indecent and irresponsible appearance will attract stern punishment. Black shoes and white socks are recommended for boys and girls. It is a serious offence for students to have in their bags other clothes than the approved uniforms. Students are not allowed to use, perfumes, keep long nails, wear rings or fly the top of their shirt. Boys must cut their hair to an even length. Blowing hair styles are not permitted. Girls are given a different hair do weekly. However, girls on low cut should make their hair very low. No put on of trouser by female students.

- 17. Students must not be found in corrupt environment (e.g. Beer parlor, public houses, cinema houses etc) during and after school. Student found in such places or engage in evil habits would be severely punished or expelled.
- 18. Students should not be found with large sum of money above N500.00. Students who keep large sum of money on them are encouraging stealing and would be disciplined. The use of handset by the students is totally prohibited. Any handset caught with students would be seized.
- 19. Display of disgraceful behaviour while in school uniform, outside the school compound is strictly frowned art.20. NO EXAMINATION MALPRACTICE

 Any students caught in such act will be seriously dealt with

20. NO IMMORAL CONDUCT

- e.g. Boy friend and girl friend, sexual harassment, sexual promiscuity from teachers to students also students to teachers will expelled.
- 21. No birthday parties will be allowed in the school. Parents and well wishers can send birthday cards to their wards. Bringing of edible things as birthday gift to the school is totally disallowed.

22. TAKE HOME ASSIGNMENT

It is a very serious offence to leave assignment undone, therefore pupils and students must ensure they do their home work daily.

23. **EXIT**

No student should go out of the school compound without prior permission obtained from the principal, registrar or head teacher.

24. The management of Dampres Private School expected all students and parents to strictly adhere to these rules and regulation. Failure to comply with them may result to strict disciplinary measures taken against defaulters.
